










Refugee flows in 2003 and 2015

(2002-2022)




Refugees hosted in each EU country (2021)






Asylum seekers in Europe




Average distance of port of disembarkation from Lampedusa



Protection rate of Afghans in Italy








Outgoing "take back" requests to Italy by Member State, and actual transfers of migrants to Italy, total 2014-2018
















